

## **Learning at Home at Dyce School**

Class teachers will share work for the week on a Monday to help families plan their week. There will be Curriculum Activities for Literacy, Numeracy and Health and Wellbeing that we suggest are done on a Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Each child will also be offered at least two google meets each week.

### **Recording Attendance during Lockdown**
